(a) Churchill, Manitoba, is a small Canadian town that has a unique relationship with its *polar bears. These animals *attract visitors, whose arrival helped save the town's economy after a military base there closed in the 1970s. Every year, tourists wanting to see the bears bring millions of dollars into the local economy.

In recent years, however, the bears have been entering the town more often in search of food. Researchers say this is because the sea ice, where the bears normally hunt, is (\mathcal{T}) due to climate change.

There are about 600 polar bears in Western Hudson Bay, which is about half the number from 40 years ago. The human population of Churchill is a little larger than the bear population.

It has been over 10 years since a polar bear attacked anyone. Townspeople look out for each other through a warning system and patrols. Sergeant Ian Van Nest, a *conservation officer, patrols Churchill's streets. Recently, he saw a group of tourists watching a polar bear. The group leader asked if they were at a safe enough distance away. "You're good," he answered. "The bear's doing his own thing and not being (</ri>

The town's former military base had a *rocket launch area, which seemed to (b) act as a deterrent to bears. However, after it was closed, local people noticed that the bears began appearing in town more frequently. To deal with this, Churchill officials created a polar bear alert program to protect community members. The town's *curfew siren (c) sounds nightly, warning people to go inside to stay safe from bears.

Mike Spence, who has been Churchill's mayor since 1996, said, "It's important that we learn to *coexist with these animals."
