IV 以下の英文を読んで、各設問に答えなさい。（*印の語句については、注釈を参照すること。）

In South Korea's capital of Seoul, Bukchon Hanok's narrow winding *alleyways date back hundreds of years to *the Joseon Dynasty. The village has become a popular (a)place to visit, especially after appearing in a television show 10 years ago.

However, the increasing number of visitors has become a problem for the *local residents. They complain about noise, trash, and *invasion of privacy. Some visitors have been caught on camera trying to enter private homes without permission, creating *conflict with local residents. Many of them have chosen to leave, leading to a 27.6 percent drop in the village's population over the past 10 years.

Village officials now want to set a (h)curfew, limiting visitors to certain areas from 5 p.m. to 10 a.m. It will start as a trial in November and will be officially *launched next March. Violators will pay fines of up to \$72.

Kwon Young-doo is a local resident and business owner. He is concerned about the curfew's aim of (c)preventing visitors from flooding the village. "Who would want to visit?" asked Kwon. "They'll leave with a bad impression of South Korea."

Others believe the curfew will be (ア). They point out that it will not *apply to visitors staying overnight in traditional houses called *hanoks*. "People come for just a day to enjoy themselves, and the noise from late-night parties is extremely loud," said Kim Eun-mee, who lives next door to a hanok. Clearing trash in front of her home has become a daily chore.

Visitors are (イ) the curfew. Some agree locals' quality of life is important. Others are unhappy at the idea of *getting fined for simply walking down a public street.
